Prohibited movements

- Turn on the haunches or pirouettes
- Lateral work in walk
- Turn on the haunches or pirouettes
- Rein Back
- Lateral work in trot
- Medium or extended trot
- Piaffe/Passage
- Canter

Riders intentionally performing prohibited movements will be deducted 8 marks (from the technical mark) on each occasion the movement is performed and the Choreography mark will be 5 or less
